Bikeability and Adult Cycle Training - Easter holiday courses at Woking Park

Surrey County Council are offering Bikeability and other cycle training courses at Woking Park during the Easter holidays. The courses are aimed at children who may have missed out on Bikeability during their time at primary school. There are also parent and teen and adult cycle confidence courses.

The courses on offer include:

Bikeability Level 1 – for riders in year 4 and above, a single morning course, taught in a traffic-free area (£9)

Bikeability Level 2 – for riders in year 6 and above, a three morning course, taught on roads with moderate traffic (£15)

Parent and Teen course – for secondary age students who have completed Bikeability Level 2 to attend with a parent so they can build confidence riding together (and the parent can see what their child has learnt). Thanks to a grant from Active Travel England, this training is currently free.

Adult Introduction to riding on roads course - aimed at adults who can ride but would like a little more confidence when cycling on roads with moderate traffic. Thanks to a grant from Active Travel England, this training is currently free.

If your child is eligible for free school meals, the training is free. Please contact <u>cycletraining@surreycc.gov.uk</u> for a discount code.

You will need to provide a bike and helmet for the training.
